We've started the Central Rockies Old-Time Music Association (CROMA) to raise money for the Rocky Mountain Old-Time Music Festival and other old-time music events. We'd also like to be the communication center for the old-time bands, musicians, and aficionados along the Front Range and beyond. We will soon have a web presence and an e-newsletter, and we aim to make CROMA a great resource for those who love to play and listen to old-time music. We would like to showcase Central Rockies-based old-time bands at our inaugural festival, which will be held at Avogadro's Number in Fort Collins on Saturday, August 28, 2010. There will be lots of music, workshops, and jamming throughout the day, indoors and out, and we're hoping that as many as possible local/regional old-time bands will be interested in playing up to a 45 minute set on-stage.
