Hambo is a sprightly couple dance from Sweden which has acquired a substantial following in the US. It consists of a walking portion followed by a series of smooth turns with a rolling feel to them. Hambo is often done at contra dances, as well as by International folk dance groups. However, since the men's and women's steps are somewhat different, it is not easy to just "pick it up" by watching others. One of the main features of the dance involves being able to pivot, so it is very important that you bring shoes with flat, smooth, hard soles. Not only is it almost impossible to do this dance in running shoes, they make it harder for your partner too. Having the right shoes greatly enhances your experience and makes the dance more accessible. -- Monday night Scandinavian classes begin at 7:30 pm, also at the Pearl Street Studio, and cost \$5.00, beginning on Sept. 12. We will follow the 4 hambo sessions with other basic dances such as schottis, vals (waltz), and snoa. Open dancing follows each class.
